

## The Villa Park Junior Women's Club Scholarship

The Villa Park Junior Women's Club is sponsoring a scholarship program to benefit two female Villa Park high school seniors. The purpose of this scholarship is to promote and reward the involvement of women in a variety of community service activities.



A \$1,000 scholarship and a \$500 scholarship will be awarded at the Senior Awards Night(s) at the recipients' high school(s) in the spring. The scholarship recipient decision will be based on the individual's community service involvement described in the application and letters of recommendation received. This scholarship is not awarded based on financial need.

### Qualifications:

- Be a current female resident of Villa Park, Illinois
- Have high school senior status
- Maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0/4.0 or equivalent (depending on scale).
- Have participated in a minimum of one (1) community service activity for a minimum of two (2) years. (This includes the current semester of application).
- Obtain two (2) letters of recommendation excluding family members.
