

## The Villa Park Junior Women's Club Scholarship

The Villa Park Junior Women's Club is sponsoring a scholarship program to benefit two female Villa Park high school seniors. The purpose of this scholarship is to acknowledge and reward the involvement of women who actively serve their community.



Up to two scholarships worth \$1000 each will be awarded at the Senior Awards Night(s) at the recipients' high school in the spring. The scholarship recipient's decision will be based on the individual's community service involvement described in the application and personal statement. This scholarship is not awarded based on financial need.

### Qualifications:

- Be a current female-identifying resident of Villa Park, Illinois
- Have high school senior status
- Will be attending an accredited college, university, community college, or trade school in the Fall of 2024.
- Maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.8/4.0 or equivalent (depending on scale).
- Have participated in a minimum of two (2) community service activities (This includes the current semester of application)
- Obtain the completed form from each community service activity. (See attached form).

**Application and completed forms must be received by April 19, 2024. Be sure to check back with your community service sponsors to remind them to return the form.**
